During its journey towards excellence the college has created many bench marks and achieved many milestones in the fields of Academics, Sports and other Co- curricular activities and has carved a niche on the academic map of the region and college was Re-accredited with A++ grade by NAAC with CGPA of 3.55/4.00 and was also a recipient of CPE grant by the UGC. It has also been conferred with 'Star College Status' by department of Biotechnology, New Delhi.

Catering to the needs of career oriented youth of today, the college offers a Spectrum of 9 Under graduate, 3 Honors, 3 Diplomas, 1 Advance Diploma, 3 Post Graduate and 3 P.G Diploma Courses.
